

Prof. Ying Fan earned her Ph.D. in System Engineering and spent 25 years at the Chinese Academy of Sciences (CAS) before joining Beihang University in 2015, where she is now Dean of the School of Economics and Management and directs the Center for Energy and Environmental Policy Research (CEEP).
