In the Chamber of Deputies, during the 2019-2023 term, she served as an official on the Energy and Fuels Committee, introducing numerous related bills and requests for information addressed to the Executive

Branch's Energy portfolio. She is a member of the Board of Directors of the General Mosconi Argentine Energy Institute and the Alem Foundation.
